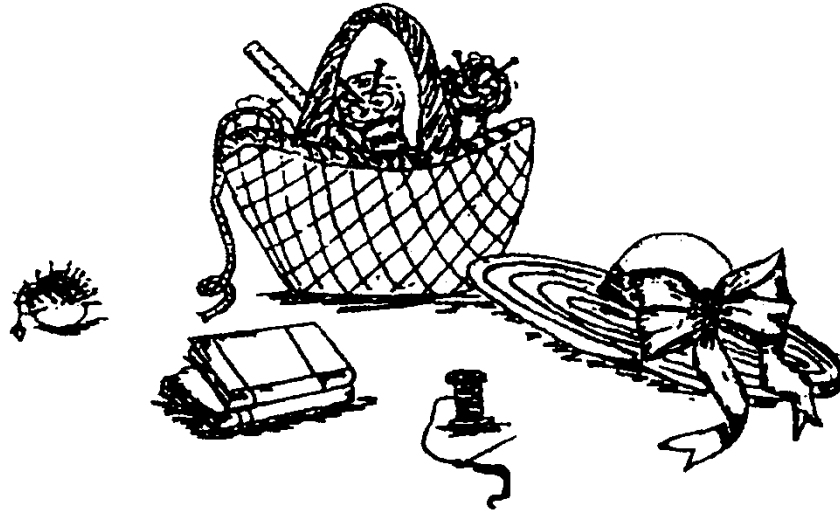

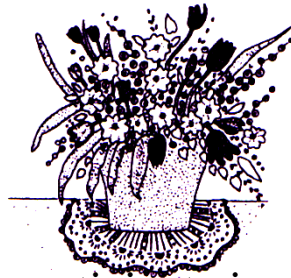

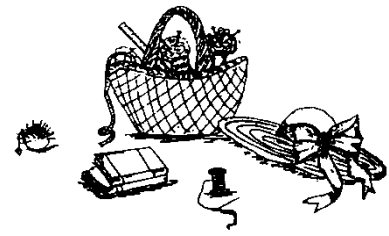
We would be delighted to have you join us for fun, food and fabulous fellowship.

# *Day Care Program*

The Day Care Program is divided into two groups: Babies up to 3 years and a program for the 4 & 5 year olds. Kimberley will set up and organize the program for the 4 & 5 year olds and the baby department, but both areas will be completely staffed and operated by those Moms using the program plus any volunteers. Only Moms attending or teaching a scheduled class or working in the daycare will be allowed to use the Day Care at the time they are attending class or are working in the daycare and they must sign up on the registration form when they will be using the day care and **all** shifts they will **be available** to volunteer in the day care. Each Mom using the daycare is asked to work **one** shift **each day**. Please register children and volunteers on the class registration sheet in the boxes indicated for Daycare.

By registering when you need use of the day care **and all times you are available** to assist we will have a better idea of how many children will be in the day care at each session, how many volunteers we need to staff it each time and who is available for a shift. Kimberley will draw up a schedule and all those involved will receive a schedule in their registration packet when they arrive at camp. This will enable us to distribute the work load in an equitable manner so everyone can enjoy their time at Dorcas Camp!

All Moms are asked to please pick up their children promptly at the end of **each** session in order that volunteers can get organized for the next session or get to any classes they are scheduled to attend. We have a canopy which we will set up at the side door of cabin 1 and enclose it with snow fencing to create a secure area.

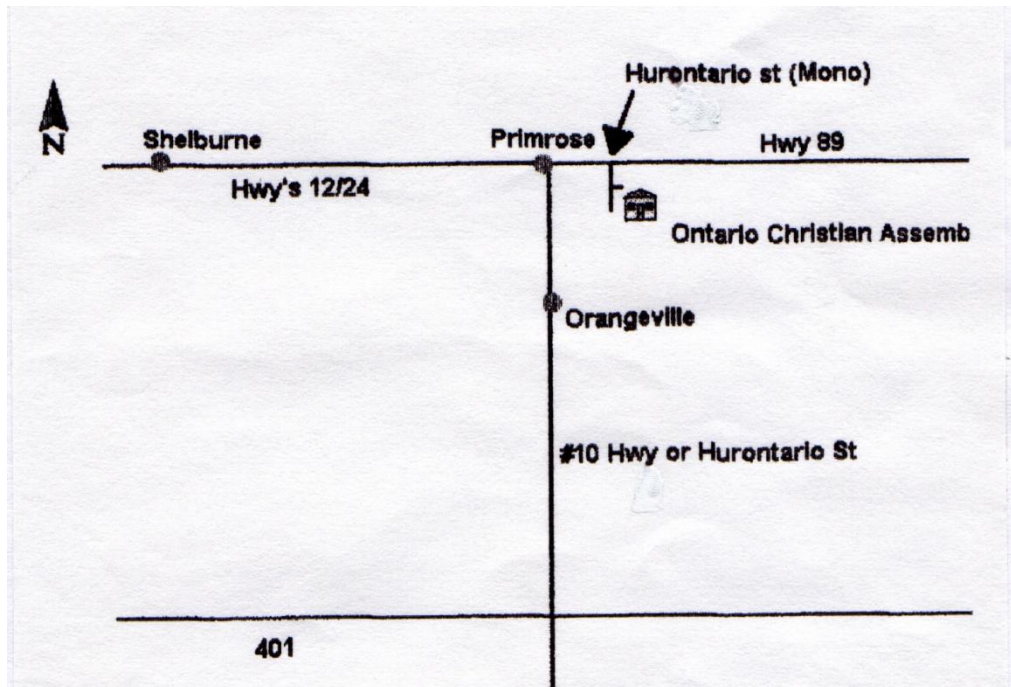

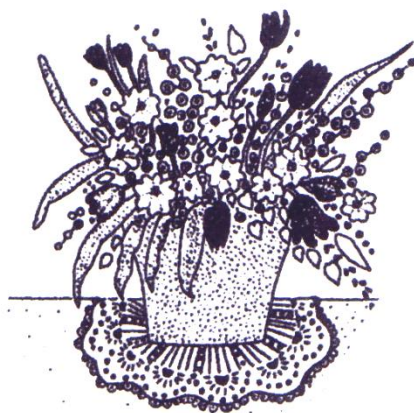
