Pool Rules and Regulations:

- 1. The Town of New Tecumseth is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- 2. No food or beverages allowed on the pool deck or in the pool.
- 3. No dogs allowed in or around the pool.
- 4. The Town of New Tecumseth reserves the right to refuse anyone the use of the pool.
- 5. No person infected with a communicable disease or having open sores shall enter the pool.
- 6. Adults and students 14 years + are responsible for younger children. Children 2 and under must wear a diaper covered by snug fitting plastic pants. If there is a pool foul, the pool will be closed.
- 7. No person shall bring a glass container of any kind into the pool area.
- 8. No boisterous play of any kind is allowed on the pool deck, pool area or in the pool.
- 9. No person shall pollute the water in any way including but not limited to spitting, spouting of water or blowing their nose in the pool.
- 10. No children 11 years or under will be admitted unless supervised by someone 14 years of age or older.
- 11. Shower regulations will be enforced. Showers must be taken before entering the pool.
- 12. The telephone, located in the guard office, is for emergency use only.
- 13. The pool may close due to weather conditions.
- 14. The maximum bather load is 550 people.
- 15. Personal Digital Assistant devices (cell phones, etc.) are not allowed in the change rooms.




